Abigail - From the Hebrew name meaning "my father is joy".

Hailey - From a surname which was originally derived from the name of a town in England meaning "hay clearing"

Hannah - From the Hebrew name which meant "favor" or "grace".

Sarah - Means "lady" or "princess" in Hebrew.

Jade - Means "he knows" in Hebrew.

Chloe - Means "green shoot" in Greek. This was an epithet of the Greek goddess Demeter.
